

Terms and Conditions:

1. Tender documents/BOQ can be downloaded up to one day prior of date of receipt and a day after publishing of advertisement in the news papers from Peshawar Development Authority web site at the address www.pda.gkp.pk. interested firms are instructed to obtain user name and password from P&D Section of Peshawar Development Authority for downloading of tender form and BOQ from the web site.
2. 2% (two percent) Earnest Money must be accompanied with the tender documents in the shape of call deposit in the name of Director General PESHAWAR DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY from scheduled Banks in accordance with the rule 20(2) of KPPRA Rules 2014 and subsequent amendments (if any). An affidavit to the effect stating that 2% bid security/earnest money has been placed in financial proposals/Bids must be attached in the Technical Proposals.
3. The submission of bids by the contractors implies that they are fully conversant with the site of work, scope of work and terms & conditions laid down in the in the tender/Bid documents.
4. The eligible contractors/firms are required to submit their Bids in separate sealed envelope i.e one envelope containing "Technical Proposals" of the contractor/firm. Clearly marked as "Technical Bid" accompanied with tender documents fee (RS: 1000/-), while the second envelop and financial propose/Bid price, clearly marked as "Financial Proposal". Both Technical and financial Proposals/Bids will be placed in single sealed envelope and addressed & send to the undersigned through courier service.
5. Technical proposals/Bids will be opened in the office of undersigned in the presence of contractors/their representatives who chose to attend on the day and time mentioned above. In case if technical Bids/proposals are not opened on the above mentioned date due to unforeseen reasons these shall be opened on the next working date at the same place & time.
6. The financial Bids/Proposals of only technically responsive qualified bidders will be opened after evaluation of technical Bids in the presence of bidders/ their representative (who may like to attend) in the office of the undersigned by the tender opening committee of PDA on the date & time as mention above whereas the "Financial Bids" of technically non responsive bidders shall be returned unopened to the respective contractors.

7. The contractors/Bidders who quoted their Bids/rates more than 10% below the engineers Estimate shall submit an additional Security in the form of call deposit equal to 8% of the estimated cost. After commencement of work by the successful bidder 8% call deposit equal should be replaced with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the schedule bank in accordance with the notification KPPRA/M&E/Estt/1-5/2016, Dated 24/5/2016 as amended on June 06, 2017.
8. In case bid becomes tie it shall be retendered.
9. Any item not reflected in the BOQ and required at site, shall be paid in accordance with MRS-(on which PC-1 is approved) with the approval of the component authority.
10. The procuring entity may reject all bids or any proposal/Bid at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposals. The procuring entity shall upon request communicate to any contractor who submitted a bid or proposal the grounds for rejection or of all bids or proposals as per KPPRA 47(1).
11. Other terms & conditions pertaining to the work can be seen in the office of the undersigned at any working day during office hours.
12. The tender documents must be signed by an authorized person of the firm.
13. Sealed bids shall be sent through registered mail/Courier service which must reach in the office of the undersigned before closing time and date mentioned above.
14. The bid documents received through fax will not be acceptable.
15. All federal and provincial duties /stamp duty /taxes including sales tax will be recoverable as per directives of the government issued from time to time.
16. If any document submitted along with bid documents found false /bogus the registration of the contractor/ firm shall stand cancelled/black listed.
17. Any disfiguring /over writing, manipulation in the tender shall be liable to rejection.
18. Only the first two figures after decimal of the rate will be considered for evaluation of the bid.
19. Contractors / firms must have valid Registration with PEC in the requisite category.
20. Any NOC or other related documents required from relevant departments will be the responsibility of successful bidder.
21. The successful bidder upon completion shall be responsible for handing/taking of the work to the relevant department.
